

What do Industrial Machinery Installation, Repair, and Maintenance Workers do?

Industrial machinery maintenance mechanics are highly skilled
workers who maintain and repair machinery in a plant or factory. To
do this effectively, they must be able to detect minor problems and correct
them before they become major. Machinery mechanics use technical manuals,
their understanding of the equipment, and careful observation to troubleshoot
the cause of the problem. Primary responsibilities of industrial machinery mechanics
often include preventive maintenance and the installation of new machinery. When the
assembly line stops because a machine breaks down, industrial machinery mechanics maintain
and repair these very different, and often very expensive, machines. They will install, dismantle,
repair, reassemble, and move machinery in factories, power plants, and construction sites. Most
major repairs are generally left to industrial machinery mechanics.

Training & Educational Opportunities

You will have plenty of employment opportunities as an industrial machinery installation, repair, and maintenance worker once you earn a certificate or associate degree in Industrial Maintenance or Electrical/Electronics Automated Systems.

As an Industrial Machinery Installation, Repair and Maintenance Worker you will:

- Clean machines and machine parts, using cleaning solvents, cloths, air guns, hoses, and vacuums
- Collaborate with other workers to repair or move machines, machine parts, or equipment.
- Collect and discard worn machine parts to maintain machinery and work areas.
