What do Supervisors of Personal Service Workers do?

Supervisors of personal service workers directly supervise and coordinate the activities of personal service workers. Overall they use excellent listening and communication skills to effectively solve various problems on the job. They frequently assign work schedules, train workers, evaluate performance, and ensure quality customer service. The work environment for these professionals is varied as they may work in a park, at a bowling alley, on a golf course, on a ship, in an air plane, or in a salon.

Training & Educational Opportunities

You will have many opportunities for employment as a supervisor of personal service workers, but first you will have to earn a certificate or associate degree and gain experience as a personal service worker prior to working as a supervisor. Your coursework will include basic computer operations, effective communication skills, and management strategy, as well as training in a specific personal care field.

As a Supervisor of Personal Service Workers you will:

- Assign work schedules, following work requirements, to ensure quality and timely delivery of service
- Observe and evaluate workers' appearance and performance to ensure quality service and compliance with specifications
- Recruit and hire staff members
- Resolve customer complaints regarding worker performance or services rendered
- Train workers in proper operational procedures and functions and explain company policies
